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although adjustment disorders ad have been included in the major psychiatric diagnostic classifications for over 50 years no book devoted solely to the topic of ad s has been published to date apart from scant coverage in psychiatric textbooks there is little to assist the doctor or therapist in understanding or making a diagnosis of ad the result is the under recognition of ad s in settings where it is believed to be a common condition in general practice where ad s are said to be the most common disorder they are seldom recognized and are misdiagnosed as depressive illness major depressive disorder or generalized anxiety disorder even among psychiatrists
