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this is a full color international discography book of 28 all girl bands from the 60s these bands helped pave the wave for all female bands of today these girls all played their own instruments and were fairly successful some gaining worldwide recognition the records listed in this book are very collectible the book includes short biographies of the bands and international discographies photos of the bands and records are included plus track listings and years presed it includes lp s 45 s ep s and mini albums a record collector guide on how to grade your records and a record industry terminology glossary is also included

the book has been formatted for easy lookup of the bands and their records

this interdisciplinary volume explores the girl's voice and the construction of girlhood in contemporary popular music visiting girls as musicians activists and performers through topics that range from female vocal development during adolescence to girls online media culture while girls voices are more prominent than ever in popular music culture the specific sonic character of the young female voice is routinely denied authority decades old clichés of girls as frivolous silly and deserving of contempt prevail in mainstream popular image and sound nevertheless girls find ways to raise their voices and make themselves heard this volume explores the contemporary girl's voice to illuminate the way ideals of girlhood are historically specific and the way adults frame and construct girlhood to both valorize and vilify girls and women interrogating popular music childhood and gender it analyzes the history of the all girl band from the runaways to the present the changing anatomy of a girl's voice throughout adolescence girl's participatory culture via youtube and rock camps and representations of the girl's voice in other media like audiobooks film and television essays consider girl performers like jackie evancho and lorde and all girl bands like sleater kinney the slits and warpaint as well as performative girlishness in the voices of female vocalists like joni mitchell beyoncé miley cyrus taylor swift kathleen hanna and rebecca black participating in girl studies within and beyond the field of music this book unites scholarly perspectives from disciplines such as musicology ethnomusicology comparative literature women's and gender studies media studies and education to investigate the importance of girls voices in popular music and to help unravel the complexities bound up in music and girlhood in the contemporary contexts of north america and the united kingdom

in this far reaching anthology david ensminger delves underground to explore the oft overlooked community of badass women who shaped the punk scene there is a common thread of women being excluded and gatekept from the hardcore music scene but this anthology challenges that notion and shows that women have still been able to overcome kick ass and shred alongside the best of them biographies interviews band anecdotes and never before published photos showcase the talent and artistry of bands like bikini kill the guttersluts bratmobile spitboy the germs the slits and dozens more through its intimate aesthetic

analysis and raw zine like presentation this is an essential resource for anyone looking to discover rediscover and cherish punk history includes a foreword by katy otto of trophy wife

based on the author s research in ho chi minh city hanoi and other urban areas in vietnam this study of contemporary vietnamese popular music explores the ways globalization and free market economics have influenced the music and subcultures of vietnamese youth focusing on the conflict between the politics of remembering nurtured by the vietnamese communist government and the politics of forgetting driven by the capitalist interests of the music industry vietnamese youth at the end of the second and beginning of the third millennium are influenced by the challenges generated by a number of seemingly opposite ideologies and realities such as the past versus the present socialism versus capitalism and cultural traditionalism versus globalization vietnam has undergone a radical demographic shift with a very pronounced youth movement and consequently vietnamese popular culture has been radically reshaped by a young population coming of age in the twenty first century as olsen reveals the way vietnamese young people cope with these opposing and contrasting forces is often expressed in their active and passive music making

women have been involved with jazz since its inception but all too often their achievements were not as well known as those of their male counterparts some liked it hot looks at all girl bands and jazz women from the 1920s through the 1950s and how they fit into the nascent mass culture particularly film and television to uncover some of the historical motivations for excluding women from the now firmly established jazz canon this well illustrated book chronicles who appeared where and when in over 80 performances captured in both popular hollywood productions and in relatively unknown films and television shows as mcgee shows these performances reflected complex racial attitudes emerging in american culture during the first half of the twentieth century her analysis illuminates the heavily mediated representational strategies that jazz women adopted highlighting the role that race played in constituting public performances of various styles of jazz from swing to hot and sweet the international sweethearts of rhythm hazel scott the ingenues peggy lee and paul whiteman are just a few of the performers covered in the book which also includes a detailed filmography

in leaders of the pack girl groups of the 1960s and their influence on popular culture musician and music historian sean macleod surveys the hundreds of girl groups that appeared not only in the united states but also in great britain during the early 1960s

this study corrects the neglect of their critical contribution of popular music history by exploring the social and political climate from which the girl groups emerged and their effect in turn on local and national music and culture macleod organizes his argument around seven leading girl groups the shirelles the crystals the ronettes the marvelettes the vandellas the supremes and the shangri las these seven sister groups serve as the basis for a broader look at the many girl groups of the period offering a roadmap through the work of the many stakeholder the singers songwriters producers and record labels that the girl group phenomenon made possible macleod also reviews the significant influence girl groups had on the many male bands of the 1960s as well as their influence on the post 60s movements from punk to new wave ultimately serving as the template for the girl groups and all girl bands that emerged in the 1980s finally the leaders of the pack brings us to the present as macleod compares the original girl groups with female performers of today drawing lines of connection and contrast between them leaders of the pack is essential reading for students scholars and fans of 1960s music and culture it will further interest anyone interested in women s studies modern american and british culture and music history with important forays into such topics as the civil rights movement second and third wave feminism and post war life

korean popular music has in the last decade become a significant model for youth culture throughout asia yet although the korean music industry is both vibrant and massive this is the first book length work devoted to the subject to appear in english the book offers a comprehensive account written by thirteen scholars of korean studies ethnomusicology and popular culture charting korean pop from the 1930s to the present day from genres imitative of early twentieth century european and japanese styles trot and yuhaengga to contemporary punk clubs rap bands and music television shows consideration is given to south korean singers who catered for us troops in the aftermath of the korean war to acoustic guitar songs and their use in the 1970s student protest movements against military dictatorship to state propaganda pop and to the explosion of global styles that marked the 1990s lyrics and dance media packaging and stage costumes song rooms and singing doctors highway songs and new folksongs as well as the impact of the internet are all explored the book also includes extensive discussion of north korean popular music and chapters on the korean wave that swept taiwan and the chinese mainland at the start of the new millennium
